$$\begin{aligned} \angle 2 &= 180^\circ - \angle 5 \Rightarrow \frac{\angle 2 + \angle 3 = 360^\circ - 5^\circ - 6^\circ}{\angle 2 + \angle 3 = 360^\circ - 240^\circ} = \\ \angle 3 &= 180^\circ - \angle 6 \end{aligned}$$

$$\Rightarrow \angle 2 + \angle 3 = 360^\circ - 240^\circ = 120^\circ$$

$$\angle 1 + \angle 2 + \angle 3 = 180^\circ$$

$$\angle 1 = 180^\circ - (\angle 2 + \angle 3) \Rightarrow$$

$$\angle 1 = 180^\circ - 120^\circ = 60^\circ$$

$$\text{Ombem: } \angle 1 = 60^\circ$$
